Annual Out of Bounds Report to Presbytery of Mississippi Valley: 2019

Theological Education

I continue to serve as Associate Professor of Philosophy and Theology at RTS-Jackson, where I teach a full load of courses each year, occasionally teach at other campuses, mentor students, and serve the institution in other ways, as asked.

I taught in East Asia again this year in two different cities and line up other teachers for a seminary program.

Writing & Scholarly Projects

I published two book chapters this year and began work on the first volume of a two-volume textbook on Reformed Moral Theology.

Preaching & Teaching

I continue to preach at least twice each month in the presbytery's churches, occasionally administering the Lord's Supper. (I sometimes also preach outside of PMV and officiated my son's wedding.)

Presbytery

I have attended each stated meeting of presbytery this year (though will be in East Asia for the August 2019 meeting.) I continue to chair the credentials committee, though will begin my last year of eligibility for that committee at our November meeting.

General Assembly

I attended GA again this year and served on the CoC for CDM and on GA's Theological Examining Committee.
