Thank you again for allowing me to labor outside the bounds of presbytery for another year as the South Region Coordinator for Evangelism Explosion International. This has been busy year since my last report with the following highlights:

Everyday Evangelism Launches: I taught in 6 launches the states of Georgia, North Carolina, Mississippi, Oklahoma, and Tennessee.

Share Your Faith workshops: I taught in 10 workshops in the states of Alabama, Mississippi, Georgia, Florida, and Virginia.

EV2 semesters: participated in 1 church in Mississippi

In May I lead our USA staff in devotions during our quarterly Day of Prayer and Fasting and at other times in the year.

In addition to these highlights I supervise 18 local coordinators over a 16-state area, recruit and train staff, advice and inform local pastors, attended presbytery meetings, carried out numerous administrative responsibilities, and coach another staff member.

I also participated in several staff orientations at our headquarters.

I taught the Winter Bible Conference at one of our sister churches in the presbytery.

I lead two workshops on evangelism at the annual Oklahoma State Baptist Evangelism conference in January as well as having an EE exhibit.

I taught in the first Mentoring for Multiplication launch held in Oklahoma City in May.
