In the past year, I have continued in the work to which this presbytery has called me, and the following is a report of my labors since the stated meeting of the presbytery in August 2018.

Service at Reformed Theological Seminary

I have taught a full load of courses in the Fall and Spring semesters of 2018-2019. I have taught courses at RTS Houston during the past year as well.

I have also been consistently involved in advising and counseling seminary students.

Service outside of Reformed Theological Seminary

My family and I attended First Presbyterian Church, Jackson, when I was not preaching elsewhere.

Since August 2018, I have preached in numerous churches in Mississippi, and two churches in Alaska. I have administered the Lord's Supper when scheduled.

I was licensed in Covenant Presbytery PCA in May 2019. I began as stated supply for Grace Presbyterian Church, Starkville, MS in June 2019.

I wrote two book reviews for *Westminster Theological Journal*, and an article for the RTS Journal

I am presently writing a commentary on the book of Hosea for Lexham Press.

In November 2018, I served as moderator for a section on Psalms and Hebrew Poetry at the annual meeting of the Evangelical Theological Society.

I also serve on the steering committee of the Psalms and Hebrew Poetry section of the Evangelical Theological Society.

I presently have several works under contract for publication.

Serving in Presbytery of the Mississippi Valley

I served on the Campus Committee as chairman through April 2019, and the Joint Committee for the state through that time as well.

I also serve on the Credentials Committee.

Conclusions and Petition for Extension of OOB Status

I am thankful for serving in the capacity to which this presbytery has called me. I do not wish to report a change in my call. My base salary has increased 2%. My housing allowance is now 40% of my RTS salary. I am grateful for the presbytery permitting me to serve out of bounds over the past year. I respectfully request that the Presbytery of the Mississippi Valley grant me person to labor out of bounds as Associate Professor of Old Testament, Reformed Theological Seminary, Jackson, MS.
