

Annual Report of Paul Nasekos to the Presbytery of the Mississippi Valley for 2019

July 7, 2019

Dear Fathers and Brothers in Christ,

Thank you for allowing me to serve Christ in this presbytery as the director for Child Evangelism Fellowship for the Greater Jackson Area. June began my fourteenth year leading our staff and volunteers, which includes adults and young people, to proclaim Christ to elementary age boys and girls in Hinds, Madison, and Rankin Counties. I respectfully request permission to continue to serve this ministry as the Lord enables me for the next year.

Several churches mentioned in this report, including this presbytery, have partnered with me or with CEF Greater Jackson Area to provide financial and prayer support. This relationship with the saints and their fellowship in gospel ministry continually encourages me to not grow weary in seeking to rescue children from the teeth of the Great Red Dragon who wants to destroy them. It is an honor to be serving the wider church with the good news of Jesus Christ.

I have had opportunities to preach at the following PCA churches: Bailey, Brandon, Columbia, Delphi, Forest Grove in Carthage, Leakesville, Meadville, Scooba, Louisville, Meadville, Union Church, Old Lebanon PCA in Ackerman, Oldenburg, Pearl, Philadelphia, Pine Ridge in Natchez, Shiloh in Pickens, Tchula, Thomson Memorial in Centreville, Waynesboro, and Woodville. I had the privilege of administering the Lord's Supper in several churches, of teaching adult SS in several churches, of moderating a congregational meeting for Louisville Presbyterian Church, and speaking in a mission conference at French Camp Presbyterian.

Dr. Joe Martin invited me to teach a mission class for the International Missions Course at Belhaven. I had the privilege of recruiting the Reverend Dr. Carl Brannan, PCA teaching elder for 36 years, to join our ministry as the Assistant to the Director and Director of Development.

At the end of the 2018-2019 school year, we had conducted 36 Good News Clubs for over 952 children being evangelized and disciplined.

For the past thirteen years, I have supervised our summer missionary training program *Christian Youth in Action (CYLA)* for junior high, senior high, and college students. This program trains youth and adults to teach 5-Day Clubs (Bible clubs) throughout the metro Jackson area.

I have continued to lead our MS State Fair outreach through the Good News Booth inside the MS Trade Mart. This ministry has continued for around 50 years. In 2018, our volunteers shared the gospel with over 3,100 fairgoers of all ages (over 400 prayed to receive Christ).

We praise God for allowing us to take the gospel to many children, youth, and adults this each year who are beyond the church. We pray that the Holy Spirit will seal the saving grace of God to the souls of those who have prayed to receive Christ as well as many more who have heard the Word of Life.

Your financial support and prayers are deeply appreciated as I continue to serve in this needy mission field. Please pray for favor as I meet with pastors and congregations to appeal to them to hear the cries of a lost generation in need of the justifying grace of Jesus Christ.
