

## Trey Adams 2018 Annual Report

Dear brothers of the Mississippi Valley Presbytery,

First of all, thank you for your support and prayer over these past seven years that we have served as missionaries in Thailand. We are so thankful for your partnership and encouragement as we labor here.

In July of 2017 we opened Grace Point Church in Chiang Mai, Thailand for weekly worship. At that time we had a core group of about 20 Thais and missionary families who were dedicated to plant a reformed church in a city with little to no reformed presence. Over the first several months we quickly grew to a congregation of 30-45 people and began to accept applications for membership. In October of 2017 we hosted our first "Welcome to the Family" camp, where one of our young men came to faith in Christ! During this camp, we invited our regular attenders to seek membership in the church and since that time we have been in the process of interviewing and shepherding these 30 Thai believers.

From late December until mid April my family were in the US for a short (but very busy) Home Ministry Assignment. We were greatly blessed by the fellowship, support and English worship that we experienced in visiting our partner churches, and God provided all of the financial support that we needed to return to the field. After an intensely busy HMA, we are glad to be back in Chiang Mai with Grace Point Church, and we are looking forward to continuing to labor in Gospel ministry among Thai Buddhists.

Please continue to pray that God will establish His Church here in Thailand, that He will protect us as we serve, and that He will open the eyes of Thai Buddhists to know and embrace Christ. Thank you and God bless!
